Of all the locations, Arkham Mansion is where the teeth feel most at home. The mansion’s intimate, claustrophobic design forces players to explore every room, making the discovery of teeth a personal journey. Unlike the open streets of Arkham City, the mansion is a character-driven space, filled with history. The **Arkham Mansion Joker Teeth** are thus anchored to a specific place and time, evoking nostalgia for

the game that started it all. Newer entries in the series built on this foundation, but the original mansion remains the most atmospheric hunting ground.
